16.9.1 Arthur Lawson (3753) was born circa 1760, probably in Liverpool. He has not been positively identified but he had a least one son, Charles.

16.9.2 Charles Lawson (3754) was baptized on the 10th of March, 1782, at Liverpool. Only his father's name was given. As a young man he moved to the Isle of Man where he married Mary Gelling on the 11th of April, 1807, at Ballaugh. He was a tailor who supplemented his income with farm work. In 1841 he and his wife were living on the Mill Easement in Ballaugh. In 1851 their widowed daughter, Mary, and her young family were living with them. In 1861 Charles and Mary were living alone at Ballaugh. Charles died in 1861 and was buried on the 13th of November at Ballaugh. See 16.10 for details of his descendants.

16.9.3 Mary Gelling (3757) was baptized on the 6th of July, 1788, at Braddan, the daughter of John Gelling & Isabella Cavendish. She married Charles Lawson on the 11th of April, 1807, at Ballaugh. She died in 1864 and was buried on the 6th of November at Ballaugh. See 16.10 for details of her descendants.

16.10.1 Mary Lawson (3758) was baptized on the 26th of April, 1808, at Ballaugh. She married Thomas Cottier on the 22nd of June, 1833, at Ballaugh. She was buried at Braddan on the 10th of October, 1877, when her age was recorded as 69 years.

In 1851, a widow, she and here two youngest children were living with her parents at Ballaugh. In 1861 she was earning her living as a charwoman and living with her unmarried daughter, Martha, at 10, Hanover Street, Douglas. By 1871 she and Martha had moved across the road to 11, Hanover Street, where both were earning their livings as washerwomen. James J Rolliston aged 10 years was living with them, apparently Martha's son. See 16.11 for details of her descendants.

16.10.1.1 Thomas Cottier (5361) was baptized on the 30th of April, 1810, at St. George's, Douglas. He married Mary Lawson on the 22nd of June, 1833, at Ballaugh. The family emigrated to New York circa 1837, where Thomas appears to have died circa 1842 when Mary and the children returned to the Island.

16.11.1 Catherine Cottier (6758) was baptized on the 1 of June, 1834, at Braddan. She did not survive childhood and was buried on the 9th of August, 1836, at Braddan.

16.11.2 Mary Ann Cottier (7053) was baptized on the 1 of June, 1836, at Braddan. She has not been identified in the 1851 census.

16.11.3 Martha Matilda Cottier (7054) was born on the 28th of May, 1839, at New York. She was baptized with her younger brother on the 12th of February, 1845, at Ballaugh. She was buried at Braddan on the 23rd of October, 1881, when her age was recorded as 42 years.

In 1851 she was living with her widowed mother at her grandparent's in Ballaugh. In 1861 she was living with her widowed mother at 10, Hanover Street, and employed as a servant. In 1871 she was living, unmarried, with her mother at 11, Hanover Street, and employed as a washerwoman. Living with them was James T Rollinson aged 10, apparently her son. In 1881 she and her son were living at 12, Hanover Street, when she was employed as a general servant.

16.11.3.1 James Thomas Rollinson was born in 1861. In 1871 he was living with his mother at 11, Hanover Street. In 1881 he was living with his mother at 12, Hanover Street and employed as a labourer. In 1891 he was boarding with Thomas & Emily Fick at 6, Hanover Street, and employed as a labourer. He was buried at Braddan on the 29th of October, 1896, when his age was recorded as 35 years.

16.11.4 Thomas Lawson Cottier (7098) was born on the 20th of December, 1841, at New York. He was baptized with his older sister on the 12th of February, 1845, at Ballaugh.

In 1851 he was living with his widowed mother at his grandparent's in Ballaugh. He has not been identified in the 1861 census.

16.14.1 Jane Cannel was born circa 1824 at Ballaugh. She married John Lawson on the 29th of November, 1874, at St. Barnabas, Douglas. She died on the 2nd of April, 1876, in Liverpool and was buried on the 7th of April at Ballaugh, when her age was recorded as 51 years.

In 1841 she was living with her parents on the Bishop's Domain, Ballaugh. In 1851–61 she was living with her widowerd father on the Bishop's Domain. In 1871 she was living with her widowered father at ballafageen, Michael.

A memorial inscription at Ballaugh reads:  
 "In affectionate remembrance of Nicholas Cannell of the  
 Bishops' Domain died July 11th 1872 aged 78 years.  
 Margaret the beloved wife of the above died  
 January 4th 1844 aged 51 years  
 Jane daughter of the above and beloved wife  
 of John Lawson died april 2nd 1876 aged 51 years"

16.15.1 Thomas Lawson (372) was born circa 1830 in Dublin, Ireland. He married firstly Elizabeth Mc Guire on the 9th of February, 1848, in Douglas, and secondly Elizabeth Kneen circa 1870 in Douglas. He died before the census of 1901. See 16.16 and 16.19 for details of his descendants.

Thomas and Elizabeth must have been very young at their marriage. No doubt they left Ireland in the face of family opposition to their marriage.

A chimney sweep by trade, in 1851 he and his family were living in Sand Street. With the family were John & Ellen Campbell described as brother and sister in-law. By 1861 the family were living in Strand Street. In 1871 the family had moved to 5, Senna Road. In 1881 their address was recorded as 7, Senna Road, but in 1891 and 1901 it had reverted to 5, Senna Road. Although the 1881 census is quite clear it probably refers to the same building.

16.15.2 Elizabeth Mc Guire (373) was born circa 1832 in County Armagh, Ireland. She married Thomas Lawson on the 9th of February, 1848, in Douglas. She died circa 1865. See 16.16 for details of her descendants.

16.15.3 Elizabeth Kneen (374) was born circa 1844, at Braddan. She married Thomas Lawson circa 1870 at Douglas. She was a widow in 1901. See 16.19 for details of her descendants.

16.16.1 Roseanne Lawson (6077) was baptized on the 6th of March, 1849, at Douglas. In 1851 she was living with her parents in Sand Street. In 1861 she was living with her parents in Strand Street. She has not been identified in the 1871 census.

16.16.2 James Lawson (6078) was born circa 1850. In 1851 he was living with his parents in Sand Street. In 1861 he was living with his parents in Strand Street and apprenticing as a chimney sweep. He has not been identified in the 1871 census.

16.16.3 Thomas Lawson (6079) was born circa 1858. He married Mary ... circa 1880 in England. See 16.17 for details of his descendants.

In 1861 he was living with his parents in Strand Street. In 1871 he was living with his parents in Strand Street and apprenticing as a chimney sweep. He must have spent some time in England for the 1881 census shows him with an English wife, Mary, and an 8 months old daughter, Mary Elizabeth, who was born in Chester. The family were living at 38, Strand Street and Thomas was employed as a chimney cleaner. In 1891 he and his family were living at 84, Strand Street. At this time Thomas was employing at least one man as a chimney sweep. In 1901 Thomas, a widower, was still living at 84, Strand Street with two of his unmarried children.

16.16.3.1 Mary Edge (6090) was born circa 1858, probably in Cheshire. She married Thomas Lawson circa 1880. She died before the census of 1901. See 16.17 for details of her descendants.

16.16.4 Elizabeth Lawson (6080) was born circa 1862. In 1871 she was a schoolgirl living with her father and step-mother at 5, Senna Road. She has not been identified in the 1881 census.

16.16.6 Charles Lawson (6082) was born circa 1865. He married Bridget Doran on the 3rd of October, 1887, at St. Mary's, Douglas. See 16.18 for details of his descendants.

In 1871 he was living with his father and step-mother at 5, Senna Road. In 1881 he was living with his father and step-mother and employed as a chimney sweep. In 1891 he and his family were living at 12, Great Nelson Street. In 1901 the family were living at 13, Nelson Street. There is a probable marriage in 1904 to either Margaret Delany or Mary Morrey.
