

The Faragher Family

Esther Faragher married John Lawson on the 3rd of February, 1787. Continued from 2.3.8 and see 14.2.2 below.

14.1 WILLIAM FARAGHER

14.1.1 William Faragher (1605) was born circa 1730. He married Alice Garrett on the 28th of May, 1757, at Braddan. He was an hatter by trade. He was buried at Santan on the 27th of April, 1794. See 14.2 for details of his descendants.

His Will of 1794 mentions his wife, Alice, his son-in-law, Philip Clague, and his grandson, John Lawson.

14.1.2 Alice Garrett (1606) was born circa 1730. She married William Faragher on the 28th of May, 1757, at Braddan. She was buried at Santan on the 4th of September, 1799. See 14.2 for details of her descendants.

Her Will of 1799 made a bequest of one guinea to her eldest daughter, Esther Lawson, and the residue to her other daughter, Ellinor Clague.

14.2.1 William Faragher (5985) was baptized on the 24th of February, 1758, at Braddan.

14.2.2 Esther Faragher (1602) was baptized on the 8th of April, 1760, at Santan. She married John Lawson (see 2.3.8) on the 3rd of February, 1787, at Santan. See 2.9 for details of her descendants.

She received a bequest of one guinea from her mother in 1799.

14.2.3 Ellinor Faragher (5986) was baptized on the 9th of May, 1762, at Santan. She married Philip Clague on the 12th of February, 1793.

14.2.3.1 Margaret Clague was baptized on the 3rd of August, 1794, at Santan.

14.2.3.2 Catherine Clague was baptized on the 1st of December, 1805, at Santan.
