- 16.12.1 Evan Lewin (5594) was baptised on the 30th of July, 1775, at Braddan. He married Mary Kinread (see Volume III, 5.15.3) on the 22nd of February, 1800, at Braddan. He was buried at Braddan on the 19th of August, 1837, when his age was recorded as 62 years, See 16.13 for details of his descendants.

- 16.13.1 Evan Lewin (5595) was baptised on the 6th of November, 1800, at Braddan. He has not been found in the 1841 census.
- 16.13.2 Margaret Lewin (5596) was baptised on the 25th of December, 1803, Braddan.
- 16.13.3 Alice Lewin (5597) was baptised on the 7th of November, 1805, at Braddan. She died just after her 21st birthday and was buried at Braddan on the 26th of November, 1826.
- 16.13.4 William Lewin (2032) was baptised on the 18th of September, 1809, Braddan. A mariner, he married Mary Lawson on the 21st of May, 1837, at Braddan, see . He died on the 30th of May, 1883, and was buried at Braddan when his age was recorded as 73 years.

In 1841 the family were living in Fancy Street, Douglas. In 1851 the family had moved to 18, Church Street. At this time William is described as a sailing captain and his age was recorded as 26 years. William was at sea on census night in 1861 when his family were living with his mother at 12, Church Street. In 1871 the family were living at 20, Church Street and William was once again at sea. Margaret Bridson, a publican's widow, is living with the family. She was described as a "relative". A niece, Ann aged 10 years, from Manchester, is living with the family. In 1881 William and Mary were still living at 20, Church Street with their youngest daughter, Mary Ellen.

- 16.13.4.1 Mary Cottier was born circa 1795 at Douglas. She has not been identified in the 1841 census. In 1851 she was living with daughter at 18, Church Street, Douglas when she was described as "mother-in-law, widow, 55, formerly laundress". In 1861 she was head of household at 12, Church Street. Her age was recorded as 77 years and her status as "mariner's widow". Her daughter and family wre living with her.
- 16.13.5 An unnamed son (5598) was baptized on the 8th of September, 1813, at Braddan. He probably died shortly after birth as no other reference has been found.

16.14.1 James Lewin (5599) was born in January and baptized on the on the 26th of August, 1838, at St. George, Douglas. He did not survive childhood and was buried on the 27th of October, 1840, at Braddan when his age was recorded as two years and ten months.

16.14.2 William Lewin (5600) was born in 1839 and baptized on the 9th of February, 1840, at St. George, Douglas. In 1841 he was living with his parents in Fancy Street when his age was given as two years. Although a burial has not been found, it is likely that he did not survive childhood as the William listed in the 1851 census is aged 8 years.

16.14.3 Esther Lewin (5601) was born circa 1840. A baptism has not been found but her age is given as one year in the 1841 census. Esther has not been found in the 1851 census nor has a burial.

16.14.4 Jane Lewin (5602) was baptized on the 4th of July, 1841, at St. George, Douglas. She died on the 7th of July, 1842, and was buried at Braddan. This information is taken from a Monumental Inscription though a corresponding entry has not been found in the Braddan burial register.

16.14.5 William Lewin (5603) was born circa 1842. A baptism has not been found but his age was given as eight years in the 1851 census when he was living with his parents at 18, Church Street. He has not been identified in the 1861 census.

16.14.6 John Lewin (5604) was baptized on the 2nd of July, 1843, at St. George, Douglas. He married Isabella Lace on the 5th of April, 1868, at Lezayre (the IGI has his name as Lewice).

In 1851 he was living with his parents at 18, Church Street. He has not been identified in the 1861 census. He was probably at sea at the 1871 census for Isabella, a master mariner's wife, is living with Frances (John's sister, below) at 18 New Bond Street. The family are at the same address in 1881 and 1891.

16.14.7 Frances Christian Lewin (5605) was baptized on the 28th of June, 1846, at St. George, Douglas. She was living with her parents and grand-mother at 12, Church Street in 1861. She probably married William Martin on the 4th of August, 1866, at Braddan. She has not been found in the 1871 census under her maiden name but Frances Martin and her children, a master mariner's wife, were living at 18, New Bond Street. The family were at the same address in 1881.

16.14.8 Joseph Gilbert Lewin (5606) was baptized on the 1st of February, 1852, at St. George, Douglas. In 1861 he was living with his parents and grand-mother at 12,

Church Street. In 1871 he was living with his parents at 20, Church Street and was employed as a clerk in the gas office. He has not been found in the 1881 UK census.

- 16.14.9 Mary Ellen Lewin (5607) was baptized on the 23rd of January, 1859, at St. George, Douglas. In 1861 she was living with her parents and grand-mother at 12, Church Street. In 1871 an 1881 she was living with her parents at 20, Church Steet. In 1881 she was employed as a dressmaker.

- 16.15.1 Robert Lewin (481) was born circa 1820.

- 16.15.2 Robert Lewin (378) was born circa 1850 at Douglas (from the 1881 census), the son of Robert Lewin senior, a tailor. He married Mary Ann Carney (see Volume I, 8.4.1) on the 4th of July, 1872, at Braddan. In 1881 he and his family were living at 4, Bigwell Street.

1851 census, Lonan 4–15, Balaligg. Robert Lewin aged 2, grandson of Robert Craine, farmer, widower.

1871—not found (20)

1881—Douglas, 5–159, 4 Bigwell Street, Robert Lewin, 30, Mariner, Mary A 30.

Robert was a mariner sailing with the Steam Packet Company of Douglas. In April of 1885 he was sailing on the SS "Louise", a coasting vessel of some 88 tons and a crew of 12, on a voyage from Milford Haven to Baltimore, Ireland. On the night of the 4th of April Robert was keeping his watch as helmsman. A strong gale was blowing and a heavy sea apprently swept him overboard. His widow was left with five young children. See 16.16 for details of his descendants.

- 16.16.1 Robert Lewin (402) was baptized on the 17th of December, 1872. He died on the 8th of October, 1875.

- 16.16.2 Margaret Ann Lewin (432) was baptized on the 2nd of April, 1874. She died aged sixty-six years on the 18th of February, 1940, unmarried and without issue.

In 1881 she was living with her parents at 4, Bigwell Street. In 1891—01 she was living with her widowed mother at 17, Bigwell Street, when she was employed as a general servant. In 1881 she was living with her parents at 4, Bigwell Street.

- 16.16.3 James Wesley Lewin (433) was born on the 16th of June, 1876. James married Esther Corran (see 13.3.3) on the 24th of August, 1913, at Braddan. The marriage

register describes him as "Postman" and gave his address as 22, Tynwald Street. See 16.17 for details of his descendants.

In 1881 he was living with his parents at 4, Bigwell Street. According to the custom of the day on the death of his father he was educated at the Bluecoat School, Liverpool. He entered the school on the 18th of November, 1887 and left on the 28th of June, 1890. In 1891 he was living with his mother at 17, Bigwell Street and was employed as a telegraph messenger. In 1901 he was still living, unmarried, with his mother at 17, Bigwell Street, at which time he was described as a general labourer.

- 16.16.4 Robert Herbert Lewin (434) was baptized on the 18th of March, 1877. He married Louisa Agnes Kelly on the 3rd of September, 1910, at Braddan. The marriage register gives his occupation as "Roper" and his address as 14, Leigh Terrace. Robert died on the 23rd of April, 1913, and was buried on the 26th at Braddan.

In 1881 he was living with his parents at 4, Bigwell Street. In 1891 he was living with his mother at 17, Bigwell Street. In 1901 he was still living, unmarried, with his mother at 17, Bigwell Street, at which time he was described as a general labourer.

- 16.16.4.1 Louisa Agnes Kelly (603) was born circa 1882, the daughter of William Kelly & Jane Cain who married the 14th of May, 1870, at Malew.

After the death of Robert, Louisa remarried and became Mrs. Mc Kibben. There was one daughter of the second marriage, Dolly, who became Mrs. Wardle. One survives in 1993.

- 16.16.5 Clara Jane Lewin (539) was born on the 18th of June, 1879. She did not survive infancy and was buried at Braddan on the 27th of July, 1880.

- 16.16.6 William Arthur Lewin (435) was born on the 22nd of September, 1881. He did not survive childhood and was buried on the 19th of July, 1888, aged seven years.

- 16.16.7 Thomas Douglas Lewin (538) was born on the 20th of May, 1883. He lived five days and was buried at Braddan on the 27th of May.

- 16.16.8 George Douglas Lewin (379) was born on the 25th of September, 1884. In 1891 he was living with his mother at 17, Bigwell Street. He married Freda May Kneal (604) on the 30th of March, 1927, at Lonan. The marriage register describes him as "a roper, of 14, Leigh Terrace". He died on the 19th of March, 1955.

There were two children of the marriage.

Margaret Lewin married Geoffrey Stubbs; two children Janet and Michael.

Dennis Lewin married Hazel Linstead; two children David George and Nicholas James.

- 16.16.8.1 Freda May Kneal (586) was the daughter of Edwin C. Kneale, builder, of Ballamillaghyn Villa, Laxey.
