

The Caley Family

Jane Caley married John Lawson on the 6th of February, 1838, at Lezayre. Continued from Voulme II, 5.28.3 and see 12.13.4 below.

Margaret Caley married William Killip on the 18th of January, 1847, at Lezayre. Their daughter married John Kinread in 1881. Continued from 21.13.2 and see

Jane Caley married Thomas Kinrade on the 16th of October, 1853. See 1.5.1 and 12.6.5 below.

12.1 Origins

12.1.1 The Manx name Caley comes from the Gaelic MacCaolaidhe, the son of Caoladh, the slender one. MacCaly, McCaly and McCalle are known in the early part of the 16th century. The modern Caley with the variations Calee and Calley are known by the middle of the 17th century. The name is most common in Lezayre, Ballaugh and Douglas.

12.2 BALLAUGH & LONAN

12.2.1 Thomas Caley (1189) was born circa 1690 at Ballaugh. The name of his wife has not been determined nor has it been proved conclusively that he was the father of John (1191).

12.2.2 John Caley (1191) was baptized at Ballaugh on the 24th of January, 1712^b3. He married Jane Cross (see 17.3.1) on the 16th of February, 1739, at Ballaugh. He died on the 2nd of November, 1765, aged fifty-three years. See 12.3 for details of his descendants.

John seems to have spent his whole life in Ballaugh. After the early death of his wife's parents he seems to have taken over the Cross family farm of Carmodal-veg and to have paid any debts that were owing.

12.3.1 John Caley (1196) was baptized on the 30th of December, 1740, at Ballaugh. Inherited land from his father and also his p̄second best close coatp̄. He also inherited the right to buy, for £4, Thomas's share of Corvle's croft. No further details are available.

12.3.2 Thomas Caley (1193) was baptized on the 18th of November, 1744, at Ballaugh. He married Mary Cowin (1194) at Lezayre Parish Church on the 31st of January, 1769, and died on the 26th of June, 1800, at Lonan.

At the death of his father in 1766, Thomas had been left an interest in a small croft which he later (1793) sold to his elder brother, John, for œ4, the price specified in his father's Will. After his marriage and birth of his first child, the family moved to the parish of Lonan, where the family appears to have flourished. Their second child, Elizabeth, was born in 1771 and their second son, Thomas, in 1773. In 1774 Thomas purchased an intack, Bollagh ne Geoye, with houses and gardens. In the same year he also purchased, for œ19, a piece of land in the Quarterland of Ballaragh. This was Abbeyland (originally belonging to the monks of Rushen Abbey) in the Treen of Skinscoe.

Thomas was evidently a successful farmer, for by 1777 he is purchasing an adjoining piece of land for œ7, complete with a kiln and houses. This was partly Abbeyland and partly Lords land. Farming or his other interests continued to prosper for by 1782, when his fourth son William was born, Thomas is buying more property: p̄two fields in the parish of Maughold known as Crotp̄jeg and Close Beg.

In 1793 Thomas sold his small croft in Ballaugh, inherited from his father, to his older brother, John. Under the terms of his father's Will the croft was sold for £4.

In 1787 Thomas became a member of the Setting Quest. This was a jury of four respected men in each parish who were responsible for settling matters of rents. Thomas attended the meeting in May, 1800, shortly before his death.

12.3.2.1 Mary Cowin (1194) was born in Lezayre, probably around 1740. She married Thomas Caley at Lezayre on the 31st of January, 1769. She continued to live in Lonan, at Bollagh na Guy, after the death of Thomas in June, 1800. She died on the 16th of November, 1824, without leaving a Will.

12.3.3 Jane Caley (1197) was born in approximately 1746 at Ballaugh. No further details are available.

12.4.1 John Caley (1198) was baptized on the 25th of January, 1770, at Lonan. He married Elinor Carroine on the 4th of November, 1797, at Lonan. He inherited part of the land in Lonan. He was buried on the 22nd of June, 1838, at Lonan when his age was recorded as 72 years (born 1766). See 12.5 for details of his descendants.

12.4.1.1 Elinor Carroine (4979) was baptized on the 18th of September, 1774, at Lonan, the daughter of Thomas arrooin. She married John Caley on the 4th of November, 1797, at Lonan. In 1841 she was living at BalaghþneþGore, Lonan, with her unmarried daughter, Elizabeth, and two grandþsons(?). There is a burial on the 9th of September, 1850, for Ellin aged 80 years of Gretch Veg, see also 14.10 below. See 12.5 for details of her descendants.

12.4.2 Elizabeth Caley (1199) was baptized on the 29th of September, 1771, at Lonan.

12.4.3 Thomas Caley (1200) was baptized on the 19th of December, 1773, at Lonan. No further details available.

12.4.4 Patrick Caley (204) was baptized on the 18th of August, 1776, at Lonan. He married Eleanor Cannon (see 14.12.6) on the 22nd of December, 1802, at Lonan. The witnesses were Thomas Fargher and John Skillicorn. Patrick was described (at the marriages of his children) as a weaver and a tailor. He probably followed both trades at various times. There is no record of Patrick or his wife ever purchasing any land. He probably lived at Gretch Veg where his widow was living in 1841 with their son Thomas. He died on the 9th of November, 1828, at Lonan. No Will has been traced. See 12.6 for details of his descendants.

12.4.5 William Caley (1201) was baptized on the 24th of November, 1782, at Lonan. He died on the 30th of August, 1836, at Lonan.

12.4.6 Philip Caley (1202) was baptized on the 22nd of March, 1787, at Lonan. He was confirmed at St. John's on

the 22nd of November, 1802. He married Esther Kelly (see 11.5.1) on the 29th of October, 1819, at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 31st of December, 1864, when his age was recorded as 77 years. See 12.9 for details of his descendants

He purchased part of the family land in 1813. In 1841 he and his family were living at BalaghþneþGore, Lonan. In 1851 he was farming 21 acres at Ballaraugh, Lonan. In 1861 he was still farming 22 acres at 15, Ballaragh. Robert Caley, a 7 years old grandþson was living with the family.

- 12.5.1 John Caley (5184) was baptized on the 20th of January, 1797, at Lonan. No further details are available.
- 12.5.2 Elizabeth Caley (5185) was baptized on the 21st of October, 1798, at Lonan. In 1841 she appears to be living with her widowed mother at BalaghþneþGore, Lonan, unmarried. She possibly had an illegitimate son, John Kewley or James Kinley, born 1826, as shown in the census of 1841 and 1851, and a second son John Caley born circa 1835, as shown in the census of 1841.
- 12.5.3 John Caley (5186) was baptized in May, 1802, at Lonan. No further details are available.
- 12.5.4 Thomas Caley (5187) was baptized on the 18th of December, 1803 at Lonan. No further details are available.
- 12.5.5 Ann Caley (5188) was baptized on the 9th of March, 1806, at Lonan. No further details are available.
- 12.5.6 Elinor Caley (5189) was baptized on the 16th of April, 1809, at Lonan. No further details are available.
- 12.5.7 James Caley (5190) was baptized on the 1st of October, 1809, at Lonan. He married Eleanor Henry (5192) on the 20th of December, 1825. There were two children of the marriage: John Caley (5193), baptized on the 10th of April, 1836, and James Caley (5194), baptized on the 28th of January, 1838. In the census of 1841 and 1851, John (b1836) is shown as living with Eleanor Caley, widow, his grandmother.
- 12.5.8 Jane Caley (5191) was baptized on the 2th of January, 1812, at Lonan. No further details are available.

- 12.6.1 Thomas Caley (1203) was baptized on the 16th of October, 1803, at Lonan. He married Anne Callow (see 13.3.1) on the 20th of December, 1845, at Lonan. From the census of 1851 it appears that Thomas followed his father as a weaver for he is shown as living at Ballachrink with his young family and is described as a plinen and woolen loom weaver^p. He was buried at Lonan on the 29th of January, 1852, when his age was recorded as 48 years. See 12.7 for details of his descendants.
- 12.6.2 Philip Caley (1204) was baptized on the 19th of April, 1807, at Lonan. An agricultural labourer, he married Margaret Callow (see 13.4.1) on the 21st of November, 1840, at Braddan. He died in a mine accident on the 12th of November, 1843. See 12.8 for details of his descendants.
- 12.6.3 Elinor Caley (1205) was baptized on the 3rd of January, 1808, at Lonan. She does not appear in the 1851 census so may have married by that date. No further details available.
- 12.6.4 Catherine Caley (1206) was baptized on the 19th of March, 1809, at Lonan. She does not appear in the 1841 census under her maiden name and so may have married by that date.
- 12.6.5 Jane Caley (448) was baptized on the 17th of November, 1811, at Lonan. In 1851 she was working at the Crescent Academy in Onchan, a girls boarding school. She married Thomas Kinrade (see 1.5.1) on the 16th of October, 1853, at Lonan. She was buried at Cronk-e-Chule on the 4th of April, 1881, aged seventy years. See 1.18 for details of her descendants.

- 12.8.1 Robert Caley (5200) was baptized on the 1st of July, 1838, at Lonan. In 1841 he was living with his parents at Gretch Voar. In 1851 he was living with his uncle

Thomas Caley and family at Ballachrink, Lonan. In 1861 he was living with his widowed aunt at 11, Ballaragh, and employed as a labourer at the mines.

- 12.8.2 James Caley (5201) was born circa 1841 at Ballaugh. In 1851 he was living with his widowed mother at Baldoon, Lonan.
- 12.8.3 Margaret Caley (5202) was born circa 1842 at Lonan. In 1851 she was living with her widowed mother at Baldoon, Lonan.
- 12.8.4 Isabella Caley (5203) was born circa 1844 at Lonan. In 1851 she was living with her widowed mother at Baldoon, Lonan.

- 12.9.1 Thomas Caley (5204) was baptized on the 25th of July, 1820, at Lonan.
- 12.9.2 James Caley (5205) was born in 1824 (age confirmed by the census of 1841 and 1851). In 1851, a mine labourer, he was living unmarried with his parents at Ballaraugh.
- 12.9.3 John Caley (5206) was baptized on the 18th of December, 1825, at Lonan. In 1851, a farm labourer, he was living with his parents at Ballaraugh, Lonan.
- 12.9.4 Mary Caley (5207) was born in 1829 (age confirmed by the census of 1841 and 1851). In 1851, a farm labourer, she was living with her parents at Ballaraugh, Lonan.
- 12.9.5 Esther Caley (5208) was baptized on the 13th of April, 1832, at Lonan. She has not been found in the census of 1851.
- 12.9.6 Elizabeth Caley (5209) was baptized on the 30th of September, 1838, at Lonan. In 1851 she was living with her parents at Ballaraugh, Lonan. In 1861 she was living with her parents at 15, Ballaragh, when she was employed as an housemaid.

12.13.4 Jane Caley (2017) was baptized on the 4th of December, 1813, at Andreas. She married John Lawson (see Volume II, 5.28.3) on the 6th of february, 1838, at Lezayre. She appears to have died before 1861. See Volume II, 5.32 for details of her descendants.
