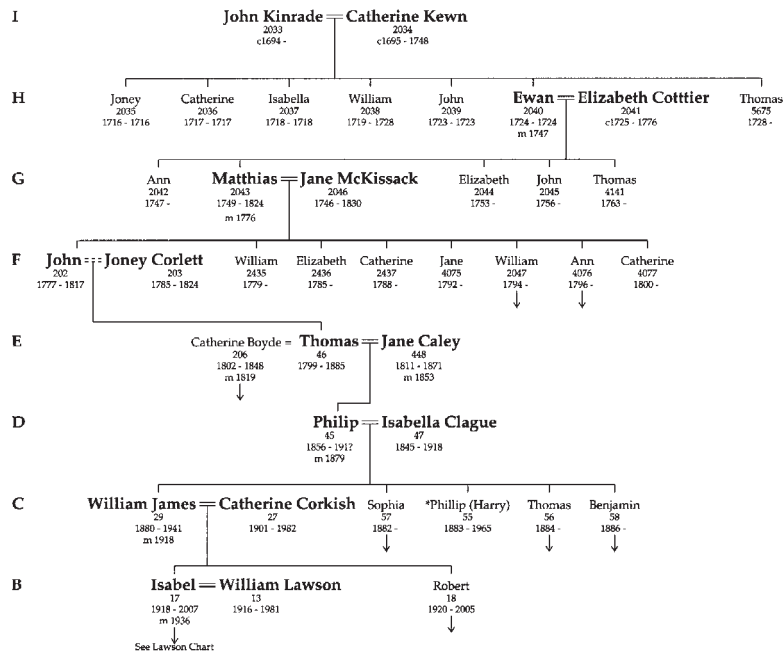

I. I Early Days

I. I. I John Kinread (2033) was born circa 1694, probably in Lezayre. He married Catherine Kewin on the 27th of August, 1715, at Lezayre. He survived his wife. There is a probable burial on the 31st of October, 1751, at Lezayre (Will film 0106220).

I. I. I. I Catherine Kewin (2034) was born circa 1695, probably in Lezayre. She married John Kinread on the 27th of August, 1715, at Lezayre. She was buried at Lezayre on the 24th of January, 1747-8.

Catherine died intestate and a Decree of Administration was issued naming her two sons Ewan and Thomas as Administrators of the estate. It was ordered that the Sumner was "to price all the good of the decedant and her husband's" which would indicate that the husband was still alive. No other children are mentioned and as Ewan and Thomas are to divide the estate between them it is assumed that the others had all died by this time.

I. 2. I Joney Kinrade (2035) was baptized on the 21st of January, 1716, at Lezayre. She probably died in infancy (burial at Lezayre on the 6th of July, 1716) as she is not mentioned in her mother's decree of 1747.

I. 2. 2 Catherine Kinrade (2036) was baptized on the 20th of May, 1717, at Lezayre. She probably died in infancy (burial at Lezayre on the 20th of July, 1717, infant) as she is not mentioned in her mother's decree of 1747.

I. 2. 3 Isabella Kinrade, (2037) was baptized on the 12th of May, 1718, at Lezayre. She probably died in infancy or childhood (3 possible burials at Lezayre) as she is not mentioned in her mother's decree of 1747.

I. 2. 4 William Kinrade (2038) was baptized on the 20th of October, 1719, at Lezayre. He probably died in childhood (burial at Lezayre on the 4th of May, 1728) as he is not mentioned in his mother's decree of 1747.

I. 2. 5 John Kinrade (2039) was baptized on the 28th of April, 1723, at Lezayre. He probably died in infancy (burial at Lezayre on the 5th of November, 1723) as he not mentioned in his mother's decree of 1747.

I. 2. 6 Ewan Kinrade (2040) was baptized on the 21st of July, 1724, at Lezayre. He was appointed Administrator, with his brother Thomas, of his mother's estate in 1747. He married Elizabeth Cottier on the 2nd of June, 1747, at Lezayre. He was buried at Bride on the 19th of January, 1774. See 1.3 for details of his descendants.

1.2.6.1 Elizabeth (Bessy) Cottier (2041) was baptized on the 28th of January, 1721-2, at Andreas the daughter of John Cottier. She married Ewan Kinrade on the 2nd of June, 1747, at Lezayre. She was buried on the 3rd of June, 1776, at Bride (Will). See 1.3 for details of her descendants.

1.2.7 Thomas Kinread (5657) was baptized on the 3rd of February, 1727-8, at Leayre. He was appointed Administrator of his mother's estate, with his brother Ewan, in 1747.

1.3.1 Ann Kinrade (2042) was baptized on the 8th of November, 1747, at Lezayre. She married Thomas Radcliffe (see Volume I, 14.13.1) on the 15th of February, 1774, at Andreas. She was buried at Andreas on the 27th of October, 1784. See Volume I, 14.14 for details of her descendants.

1.3.2 Mathias Kinrade (2043) was baptized on the 27th of February, 1749, at Lezayre. He married Jane Mc Kissack (see 22.2.2) on the 30th of November, 1776, at Bride. He was buried at Bride on the 17th of October, 1824, when his age was recorded as 75 years. See 1.4 for details of his descendants.

1.3.3 Elizabeth Kinrade (2044) was baptized on the 9th of December, 1753, at Lezayre. No further details available.

1.3.4 John Kinrade (2045) was baptized on the 24th of November, 1756, at Lezayre. No further details available.

1.3.5 Thomas Kinrade (4141) was baptized on the 27th of August, 1763, at Bride. (N.B. listed as Kingread in the I.G.I.)

1.4.1 John Kinrade (202) was baptized on the 2nd of March, 1777, at Bride. In 1799 his illegitimate son by Joney Corlett (see 7.24.2) was born. He left the Island in late 1798 or early 1799. It is presumed that he went to England, but this has not yet been confirmed. At the second marriage of his son Thomas, John was described as a tailor. See 1.5 for details of his descendants.

There is a marriage recorded at Lezayre on the 29th of July, 1797, between John Kinread and Joney Corlett. This must be another couple.

- I.4.2 William Kinrade (2435) was baptized on the 25th of May, 1779 at Bride. No further details available.
- I.4.3 Elizabeth Kinrade (2436) was baptized on the 9th of January, 1785, at Bride. No further details available.
- I.4.4 Catherine Kinrade (2437) was baptized on the 12th of May, 1788, at Bride. She did not survive infancy.
- I.4.5 Jane Kinrade (4075) was baptized on the 17th of January, 1792, at Bride.
- I.4.6 William Kinrade (2047) was baptized on the 23rd of November, 1794, at Bride. A mason by trade, he married Margaret Wade on the 8th of November, 1817, at Bride. In 1841 he was living at Ballaben, Bride, with his wife and family. He appears to have died before the census of 1851 but a burial has not been located. See 1.24 for details of his descendants.
- I.4.6.1 Margaret Wade (2438) was born circa 1780. She married William Kinrade on the 8th of November, 1817, at Bride. See 1.24 for details of her descendants.

In 1851, a widow, she was living at Ballacouder, Bride, with her youngest daughter. She was employed as a farm labourer. In 1861 she was living in Bride and employed as an agricultural labourer. In 1871 she was living on charity at Back Strand Street, Douglas, aged 78 years. She has not been found in the 1881 census nor has a burial been located.

- I.4.7 Anne Kinrade (4076) was born circa 1796 though she was not baptized until the 5th of March, 1800, at Bride. She married Patrick Crellin (see 7.13.9) on the 3rd of May, 1815, at Jurby. She was buried at German on the 19th of April, 1873 when her age was recorded as 78 years. See 7.14 for details of her descendants.

In 1841 the family were living at Knockbrech, German. In 1851 she and her family were living at Cronk Breck, German. In 1861, a widow, she was living with her unmarried son, Caesar, at Knock Breck. In 1871 she was living with her married son, John, at 4, Slieuwhallin, Patrick.

- I.4.8 Catherine Kinrade (4077) was baptized on the 5th of March, 1800, at Bride. She was buried at Marown on the 3rd of March, 1867, when her age was recorded as 68 years.

In 1841 she was living, unmarried, with her sister Ann and family at Knockbrech, German, and employed as an house servant. In 1851 she appears to be living as a house servant with the family of Hugh Fargher at Bollagh, German. In 1861 she was living with John Faragher at Ballacha, German.

- I.5.1 Thomas Kinrade (46) was born, most probably, in February or March of 1799. We know that it was before the 6th of March, 1799, when he was baptized at Andreas,

and that he was not yet twenty-one years of age when he married on the 13th of May, 1819, and so must have been born after the 13th of May, 1798. He appears in the five census of 1841-81 when his age is given as 40-44, 55, 64, 76 and 85 respectively. At his second marriage in October, 1853, his age is given as forty-four though he was actually fifty-four. At his death in May, 1885, his age is given as ninety years. Given the standards of literacy and numeracy of the times, these variations in age are not unusual.

As a young man he worked as a farm labourer. He married Catherine Boyde on 13th of May, 1819, at Andreas Church. Thomas married with permission of his mother, Joney, as he was underage. Ten children of this marriage have been located, see 1.6.

The census of 1841 shows him living at Balla Shaane, Andreas, with his children Catherine, James, Thomas and Margaret. His wife and eldest son seem to be living at the farm of William Cleator, see 1.5.2 below. His age is given as 40 years, i.e. 40-44, and his occupation as "agricultural labourer". He was still working as an agricultural labourer at Andreas at the census in 1851.

After the death of his first wife, Catherine, Thomas moved to Lonan where he worked in the mines and married his second wife, Jane Caley (see 12.6.5), on the 16th of October, 1853 in the parish church of Lonan. Thomas is described as a forty-four ear old widower and Labourer of the parish of Lonan, the son of John Kinrade, Tailor. Jane Caley is described as a forty year old spinster of the parish of Lonan, the daughter of Patrick Caley, Tailor. Both parties made their mark and the witnesses were James Caley and John Fargher.

The census of 1861 shows Thomas living at Cronk-e-chule, Lonan, aged 64, a mine labourer, with his second wife, Jane, and their son Philip, see 1.18.

Thomas died on the 25th of October, 1885 at Gretch Voar, Lonan. The informant was his son Philip of the same address who stated that his father was aged ninety.

- 1.5.2 Catherine Boyde (206) was baptized on the 12th of September, 1802, at Michael, the daughter of William Boyde & Catherine Cannell. She married Thomas Kinrade on the 13th of May, 1819, at Andreas. She died in 1848 and was buried on the 19th of February at Andreas, when her age was given as forty-seven years. See 1.6 for details of her descendants.

At the census of 1841, Catherine appears to be living on the farm of William Cleator when her age is given as 40 years and her occupation as "spinner". There is a John Kinread, aged 20 years, a "male servant", living at the same address, possibly her eldest son. The rest of the family are recorded under another entry.

- i.6.1 John Kinrade (231) was baptized on the 5th of November, 1820, at Andreas. He married Mary Ann Mastin on the 9th of February, 1850, at Maughold (see 15.6.1). He died in 1886 and was buried at Maughold on the 28th of February. See 1.7 for details of his descendants.

His first child Margaret Ann Kinrade was baptized 26th of January, 1843, seven years before his marriage. The names of both parents are listed at the baptism and it is marked "illegitimate" in the Maughold Register.

In 1841 he was working with his mother on the farm of William Cleator at Balla Shaane, Andreas. He would have been 30 years old at the 1851 census but so far has not been identified although his wife and family have been found at Ballasholagne, Maughold. He was probably fishing on census night. In 1861 the family is living at Church Road, Maughold, and John is described as an iron miner. In 1871 the family were living at Cardle Moar, Maughold. John's occupation was given as lead miner. In 1881 the family were living at Dhoon and John is now described as a shoemaker.

- i.6.2 Mary Ann Kinrade (232) was baptized on the 14th of February, 1823, at Andreas. In 1841 she and her younger brother, William, were living and working for Ewan Clark, a tanner, in Ramsey. In 1851 she was working for Daniel Christian at Andreas.

- i.6.3 Thomas Kinrade (233) was baptized on the 28th of August, 1825, at Andreas. A burial has been noted at Andreas on 23rd of December, 1834, for Thomas Kinrade, aged eleven years.

- i.6.4 William James Kinrade (234) was baptized on the the 8th of October, 1828, at Andreas. In 1841 he and his older sister, Ann, were living and working for Ewan Clarke, a tanner, in Ramsey. He would have been twentytwo years old at the time of the 1851 census when he appears to have been a farm labourer living in the home of Thomas Lace at Bride. He has not been found in the 1861 census.

- i.6.5 Catherine Kinrade (235) was baptized on the 20th of March, 1831, at Andreas. She married John Kelly (see Volume I, 11.10.1) on the 31st of January, 1857, at Maughold. She was buried on the 30th of January, 1881, at Lonan when her age was recorded as 52 years. See Volume I, 11.11 for details of her descendants.

In 1841 she was living with her father at Balla Shaane, Andreas. She appears to have been known as Kitty and in the 1851 census she is shown as being unmarried, twenty years old and a servant in the home of John James Stavely of Ballseyre House, Andreas. In 1861 she was living at 37, Maughold Street, Ramsey, with her husband and three daughters. In 1871 the family had moved to Laxey.

- i.6.6 James Kinrade (236) was baptized on the 8th of December, 1833, at Andreas. He married Sarah Allen (see 7.9.5) on the 10th of February, 1855, at Lezayre. He died in 1902 and was buried on the 22nd of November at Lonan. See 1.10 for details of his descendants.

He was living with his father in 1841 at Balla Shaane, Andreas. At the time of the 1851 census he appears to have been a farm labourer living in the home of Paul Taggart at Bride. In 1861 he is farming 16 acres at Lough Dhoo, Ballaugh, with his wife Sarah. Living with the couple is James Cannon, aged four years (born Lonan), a nephew. By 1871 the family had moved to Lonan and were living at 9, Minorca Hill, where James was employed as a miner. In 1881 the family were living at Ballacowell, Lonan. In 1891 the family were living at 9, Minorca when James and his son Thomas were employed as 'Drawers' at the mines. In 1901, a widower, he and his son Joseph were living at Minorca.

- 1.6.7 Thomas Kinrade (237) was baptized on the 1st of May, 1836, at Andreas. He married Sarah Cannon (see 14.9.4) on the 2nd of May, 1857, at Lonan. He was buried at Lonan on the 10th of August, 1902, when his age was recorded as 63 years. See 1.14 for details of his descendants.

In 1841 he was living with his parents at Balla Shaane, Andreas. He has not been identified in the 1851 census. In 1861 he and his young family were living at Rhencell, Lonan, where he was employed as a lead miner. In 1871 the family had moved to Dumbells Road. In 1881 the family were living at 7, Mine Road. By 1891 Thomas had left the mines and become a publican. The family had moved a few doors along Mine Road and were residing at No. 3, The Bridge Inn. In 1901 the family were living in New Road and Thomas was still listed as a "licensed victualler".

- 1.6.8 Margaret Kinrade (238) was born in 1839, most probably in Andreas, but so far no record has been found. She married Thomas Corkill (see 7.28.5) on the 29th of June, 1861, at Ramsey, when her age was recorded as 22 years. See 7.29 for details of her descendants.

In 1841, aged 3, she was living with her father at Balla Shaane, Andreas. At the 1851 census she is shown as twelve years of age living at home with her widowed father and two younger sisters. In 1861 she was working as a general servant to Thomas & Jane Caine at Gliack House, Ballaugh. In 1871 she and her family are living at Ard where her husband was farming 15 acres.

When her father (and possibly her younger sisters) moved to Lonan Margaret appears to have remained in Andreas living with her grandfather "Old Cammedy". The record of confirmations at Andreas on 1st of October, 1854 show her as living with her grandfather and being a servant at Coven's.

So far the grandfather has not been identified: either John Kinrade (202) or the father of Catherine Boyde. (No elderly, male Boyd found in the 1851 census for Andreas. No suitable John Kinrade has been found in the census.)

- 1.6.9 Jane Kinrade (239) was baptized on the 3rd of October, 1841, at Andreas. The 1851 census shows her living at home with her widowed father and two sisters.
- 1.6.10 Elizabeth Kinrade (240) was baptized on the 6th of February, 1844, at Andreas. At the 1851 census she is shown as seven years of age living at home with her widowed father and two elder sisters. In 1861 she was working as a house servant for Lee Kewley at Ballacraggan, Lonan, when her age was given as nineteen years.

- I.7.1 Margaret Ann Kinrade (2470) was baptized on the 26th of January, 1843 at Maughold. The baptism is marked as "illegitimate" though the names of both parents are recorded. She married James Leece on the 23rd of September, 1864, at Maughold. She died on the 17th of October, 1891, at Auckland, New Zealand. See 1.8 for details of her descendants.

In 1851 she was living with her parents at Ballasholagne, Maughold.

- I.7.1.1 James Leece (2483) was baptized on the 27th of December, 1840, at Rushen, the son of Thomas Leece & Jannett Davidson. A labourer and miner, he married Margaret Ann Kinrade on the 23rd of September, 1864, at Maughold. He died at Auckland, New Zealand, on the 26th of November, 1932.

- I.7.2 Mary Jane Kinrade (2471) was baptized on the 11th of August, 1850 at Maughold. She was buried on the 1st of March, 1854, at Maughold aged four years.

- I.7.3 Maria Kinrade (2472) was baptized on the 26th September, 1852, at Maughold. She was buried on the 19th of March, 1854, at Maughold aged eighteen months.

- I.7.4 John James Kinrade (2473) was baptized on the 9th April, 1854, at Maughold. He married Mary Ann Kinrade (see 3.8.5.) on the 20th of October, 1888, at Maughold. See 1.9 for details of his descendants.

In 1861 he was living with his parents at Church Road, Maughold. In 1871 he was working as a baker and living with his parents. In 1881 he appears to have been fishing on "Matchless". In 1891 he was employed as a highroad labourer and living at Sea View Cottage, Dhoon with his wife and family. In 1901 the family were living at 36, Becksid Road, Dalton in Furnes, where John was working as a labourer in an iron foundry.

- I.7.5 William Henry Kinrade (2474) was baptized on the 25th of December, 1856, at Dhoon, Maughold. He was buried on the 2nd of October, 1919, at Alexandra, New Zealand.

In 1861 he was living with his parents in Church Road, Maughold. In 1871 he was living with his parents in Maughold. He emigrated to New Zealand where he married Sarah Weller Jackson on the 8th of July, 1895, at Alexandra, see 9.17.

A son, John Harry, by Margaret Ann Callow, was baptised on the 15th of April, 1885, see 9.2.

- I.7.5.1 Margaret Ann Callow (2484) was baptized on the 28th of June, 1867, at Maughold, the daughter of Daniel Callow and Ann Jane Bannan.

- I.7.5.2 Sarah Weller Jackson (2486) was born on the 23rd of September, 1873, at Hyde, New Zealand. She died on the 29th of July, 1920, at Dunedin, New Zealand.

- I.7.6 Thomas Edward Kinrade (2475) was baptized on the 8th of December, 1859, at Maughold. He did not survive infancy and was buried on the 12th of February, 1860, at Maughold aged 9 weeks.

- I.7.7 Robert Alfred Kinrade (2476) baptized 28th November, 1860, at Maughold. He did not survive childhood and was buried 13th March, 1862, at Maughold.

- I.7.8 Ann Elizabeth Jane Kinrade (2477) was baptized on the 8th July, 1863, at Maughold. She was buried on the 3rd of February, 1864, at Maughold.

- I.7.9 Eliza Christian Kinrade (2478) was baptized on the 28th February, 1866, at Dhoon. In 1871 she was living with her parents. She married Lawrence Stephen Caine on the 25th of June, 1892, at St. Thomas, Douglas, see Volume II, 11.30.2. She died on the 22nd of November, 1933, and was buried at Douglas Borough Cemetery on the 24th. see Volum II, 11.31 for details of her descendants.

- I.9.1 Kendall Kinrade (4653) was born on the 24th of March 1889 and was baptized on the 5th of May, 1889, at Dhoon. In 1891 he was living with his parents at Sea View Cottage, Dhoon. In 1901 he was living in Dalton in Furness with his parents.

- I.10.1 John James Kinrade (2465) was baptized on the 4th of September, 1861, at Ballaugh. He married Eleanor Corkill on the 1st of June, 1889, at Andreas.
- In 1871 he was living with his parents at 9, Minorca Hill, Laxey. In 1881 he was living with his parents at Ballacowell, Lonan, and employed as a lead miner.
- I.10.2 William Allen Kinrade (2466) was baptized on the 10th of December, 1865, at Lonan. He married Emma Kewley (see Volume II, 15.25.4) on the 26th of May, 1888, in Douglas. He died before the census of 1901.
- In 1871 he was living with his parents at 9, Minorca Hill, Laxey. In 1881 he was living with his parents at Ballacowell, Lonan, and employed as a lead miner. In 1891 he and his family were living at 19, Dumbells Terrace, Laxey and he was employed as an engine driver at the mines. He would appear to have died between 1894 and 1901 although a burial record has not been found.

- I.19.1 William Philip Kinrade (45) was baptized on the 30th of November, 1856, at Lonan. He married Isabella Clague (see Volume I, 7.11.1) on the 18th of October, 1879 at Kirk Braddan. Both were single, of full age and residing in Douglas. Philip gave his occupation as labourer, but was probably an unemployed lead miner. Isabella was the daughter of Robert Clague (48), a farmer. The witnesses were Eleanor Wade, Fletcher Kinrade and Thomas F. Hutchinson. Philip died in South Africa. See I.20 for details of his descendants.

The census return of 1881 shows Philip and Isabella living at Gretch Voar, Lonan, with their sons John Robert (170), aged five years, and William aged one year. Using the census data, John Robert would have been born in 1876, before Philip and Isabella were married. Isabella is known to have had two illegitimate sons before marrying Philip. One of these sons was John Robert Clague (170) born in 1876, and it is assumed that this is the same John Robert listed on the 1881 census return. Philip's age is given as twenty-four (which is consistent with the returns for 1861 and 1871). Isabella's age is given as twenty-six, i.e. two years older than Philip, giving her a year of birth as 1855. However this conflicts badly with the information in the Clague Family, where Isabella is shown as being baptized on the 20th of April, 1845 at Lonan, see Volume I, 7.11.1. The baptismal records are likely to be more accurate than the census returns. Philip undoubtedly knew that Isabella was older than he, but he may not have been aware that she was twelve years older. There could have been an enumeration error, or possibly he was a gentleman and turned a blind eye.

Philip Kinrade left the Island in either 1899 or 1900, when he would have been approximately forty-four, with his step-son Alfred Clague (169) to try his luck in the South African gold mines. A letter dated the 4th of July, 1900 indicates that he was working for the Jumpers G.M. Co (Gold Mining Company). He died in South Africa prior to April, 1901. As a miner he had been earning very good money, one suggestion puts his earnings as £15 per day - a considerable sum in those days. At his death, his widow was left in very straightened circumstance. At approximately the same time Alfred became quite wealthy though he does not appear to have helped his widowed mother. A rift developed between Alfred and his mother at this time, see Clague family notes.

In 1891 Isabella was keeping a boarding house at 8, Windsor Road. In 1901 she was living at 15, Richmond Grove, Douglas, with 6 of her unmarried children and Margaret Clague, a married aunt, and William Clague a young cousin. She was buried on the 30th of March, 1918, at Braddan.
